Human Rights



We support and respect the fundamental human rights universally recognized within our paradigms and sphere of influence since our affiliation to the United Nations Global Compact, making emphasis on administrative, academic and operative activities.

In our various information dissemination and actions for our community we did emphasized the universal recognized human rights, which all are enforceable regarding their relation with other rights and can invoke the general principles of human rights such as equality and non discrimination or the right to effective judicial protection, developing and affirmative action on international higher education, based on rigorous entry requirements and academic quality; and supporting all those employees that offer equal opportunities for all qualified personnel regardless race, religion, color, sex, age, origin, ancestors, physical or mental disabilities or veteran status.

On second semester 2019, in our editorial we dedicated it to Ethics and Business Policies, and spreading our commitment with United Nations Global Compact. https://tauniversity.org/editorial/la-etica-y-las-politicas-empresariales

Principle 2: To make sure they are not complicit in human rights abuses.

We promoted in students the consideration of topics, matters and researchs related with human rights. In that regard we started on November 2020 the Postdoctoral Program in Studies of Democracy. So there is a close relation between them because they are elements of a rule of law that share an elemental premise: to allow those who are governed to live with dignity and their participation in Democracy.

Among the investigations that the students of the Postdoctoral Program will accomplish is the interesting and contemporary research of the problematic electoral processes made electronically

in Latin America: expectations and possibilities. By the end of January 2021 is programmed the finalization of course 1 of research on advanced topics in contemporary democracies which will arise a postdoctoral investigation report and available at the website of TAU in the publishing section for all to see.

Democracy is the basis of the rule of law and an indispensable requirement for the effective exercise of all human rights.

Everyone has the right to democracy and the states must promote and defend it.

Labor sphere



TAU is aligned with this principle that supports freedom of association and the effective recognition of the right to collective negotiation. The university supports the elimination of all forms of forced labor or labor done under duress, and the eradication of child labor as well as the abolition of discriminative practices on employment and occupation.

In the labor sphere and in general, since March 11, 2020, the Global Health Organization catalogued the spreading of the disease of Corona Virus as Pandemic. The contagious situation nowdays and the following-up done by our university is yet unknown rebounding on labor, businesses, finance, family, sanity, economics, society and security, among others, great affectation since it appearance in China and the non transparent aspects surrounding the facts, and the question of not returning to normal.

TAU regarding this matter, has done various consultations and verifications during the lapse involving the present report, based on diversity of sources, finding out that despite efforts in avoiding child labor, it is still representing the worst violation on child rights. According with UNICEF more than 160 million of childs work worldwide which implies risks in physical, mental and social development.

There is a special concern regarding the worst form of child labor such as sexual exploitation, children recruiting for soldiers and children trafficking.

We also believe that effective strategies to eradicate child labor is by reducing drastically poverty and allowing access to qualified and pertinent education, bringing out quality employment to adults responsible for children, avoiding social rules that promote child labor.

TAU developes an affirmative action on international higher education, non traditional for adults based on rigorous requirements and supports those employers that offer equal opportunities for

everyone qualified regardless race, religion, sex, color, age, origin, ancestors, physical or mental disabilities and veteran status.

Anti-curruption



The university supports legal iniciatives and measures against all forms of curruption including extorsion and bribery, these are fundamental aspects for a better world.

The position of TAU on this regard urges the advocation of this phenomenon, that it cannot be seen as normal or being permissive with such behaviors, these are trully an evil to be fought.

Not only becouse it consumes resources that could be destined to areas such as health, education and inequalities reductions but also becouse curruption favors certain private interests in detriment of collective interests which destroys the moral and digninity of the population of a country, also of the employees of organizations affecting even the families of that population.

We share the position of the german professor Johann Graf Lambsdorff, the creator in the 90's of The Index of Curruption Perception used by International Transparency, indicating that the search for a good side of curruption is pointless.

Punishments are necessary and have deterrent effects in order to avoid certain practices. However and parallel, it is necessary to invest more on prevention which really brings practical effects.

Preventive methods such as offering rewards for ethic behaviors and pshycological motivation in order to adopt good practices are alike important to fight curruption.

During this period TAU organized and carried out a postdoctoral research called "Ética Internacional; Derechos, Responsabilidades, Obligaciones" which were published for all to see.

On second semester 2019, as we mentioned below, we dedicated our editorial to this matter and we entitled it "Ética y las Políticas Empresariales" and published on https://tauniversity.org/editorial/la-etica-y-las-politicas-empresariales
