**French Riviera and Monaco tour**

*Meeting point: Intercontinental Carlton Hotel reception.*

At the enchanting hillside village of Eze you will be rewarded with panoramic views of the French Riviera and Mediterranean sea. You will also get the chance to visit the Fragonard perfume factory before driving through the village of la Turbie. Also known as the “terrace” of Monaco, due to the panoramic views of the principality of Monaco, it is most notable for its roman monument dating from 7 BC. On arrival in Monaco, visit the old town, known as “the rock,»” and admire the prince palace. You will arrive in time to see the changing of the guard just before midday. Continue to the Cathedral, where you can pay homage to the princes and princesses of Monaco who are buried there and still have time to see the oceanographic museum and the justice palace. End your thrilling tour at Monte Carlo, where you will see the casino built by Garnier, the architect of the Opera Garnier in Paris. Look out too for the famous Hôtel de Paris built in 1864, and the beautiful gardens. But for many, the highlight of the tour will be when your driver takes you for a spin around the road circuit of the Monaco grand prix.
